#### Introduction

The 'Logs' section of the console can be used to display the number of active clients, users and Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) actions over a period. This is often used to determine usage statistics for your devices and information obtained can also be exported for later review by others.

# Viewing Client status using the 'Logs' Console.

Follow the steps below to access the 'Logs' page once you have logged in to the console.

Select 'Logs' and 'Machines' to display a list of devices that match the 'filters' criteria on the left.




Figure 1 -Logs - Machines

Note that it usually beneficial to change time beyond the default of 24 hours to list more devices.

Each column contains a variety of different data under each heading and the figures reported are 'links' which can be selected to view in more detail.




Figure 2 - Links to specific data

# Viewing User status using the 'Logs' Console

Select 'Logs' and 'Users' to display a list of user activity that match the 'filters' criteria on the left.




Figure 4 -Logs - Users

Each column contains a variety of different data under each heading and the figures reported are 'links' which can be selected to view in more detail.

### **Viewing Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) Logs**

Follow the steps below to access the 'Logs' pages to display information acceptance or refusal of the Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) if in use for your user groups.

Select 'Logs' and 'AUPs' to display a list of AUP logs that match the 'filters' criteria on the left.




Figure 7 -Logs - AUPs

Each column contains a variety of different data under each heading and the figures reported are 'links' which can be selected to view in more detail.

The following image shows an example of what would be displayed if the link above were selected.




Figure 9 - Specific data displayed
